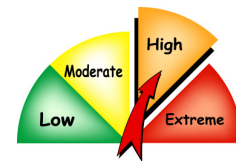

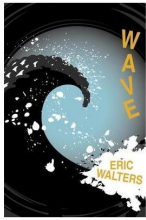
**Aug 11th - GBLT LANDMARK series - Bird Physiology and Migration with Dr. Chris Guglielmo**



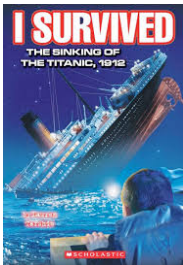
The GBLT LANDMARK Speaker Series presents leading conservation topics in communities around Georgian Bay. All events are free, and light refreshments will be served.

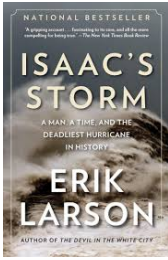
## Aug 19th - 23rd - Sailing Camp
