Dear Cottagers and our extended Sans Souci Family.

Before we begin, we hope that you and your family are staying safe and healthy. It is April 5th when this letter was prepared and there will likely still be at least 5 days left of ice at the marina [Update: All gone]. Regardless, the Ontario Government has severely restricted our operational ability. While the store remains open at this time we are unable to deliver boats to any customers. Nor are we permitted by law to transport any person except to their permanent residence. We do not know when these restrictions will change..... more info...



GBA Water Levels Report - Apr 25, 2020



Water levels continue to be well above average and near or above record high levels, but the difference from last year's level for Lake Michigan-Huron has declined by 3 inches over the last week (from 14 to 11 inches higher) reflecting the drier conditions.

From a month ago the water levels on Lakes Superior, **Michigan-Huron**, St Clair, Erie & Ontario are **up 2**, **3**, 2, 3, 6 **inches** respectively.....more info...
