With these extreme hot weather conditions, many areas are extremely dry and highly prone to risk of fire. In the past two weeks there have been two fires reported in our area. So, we are sending this eAlert to make you aware of the current fire rating and rating information.



The Township as well as the surrounding townships in the West Parry Sound region continue to set the Fire Danger Rating at **Extreme**.

This means **no open burning of any kind, no fireworks and there are NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Once we get some much needed rain, the fire rating will be lowered.
