Work Period & Schedule

Season: April – October (exact start/end dates may vary) **Hours:** 8 AM – 5 PM (with scheduled lunch and breaks)

Commitment: Minimum of 40 hours per week/Maximum 50 hours per week

Position Summary

The **Maintenance Team** ensures that ICFC's facilities, docks, boats, and grounds are safe, functional, and beautiful throughout the season. This hands-on role requires physical work, problem-solving, and a passion for outdoor tasks.

Key Responsibilities:

- General maintenance of campgrounds, cabins, and common facilities
- **Dock maintenance:** seasonal setup, repairs, and winterization
- **Groundskeeping:** mowing, trimming, raking, landscaping, and garbage collection
- Preparing and winterizing boats for seasonal transitions
- Assisting with small projects (painting, carpentry, basic plumbing)
- Operating the **boat taxi service** and running errands (**Ontario Boating License required**)

Seasonal Duties:

- In-Season (June August):
 - Deploying and maintaining boats
 - Dock repairs and upkeep

- Daily grounds maintenance and support with camp events
- Assisting members with light facility repairs
- Out-of-Season (April June & September October):
 - Opening/closing cottages and camp facilities
 - Repairing damage from winter weather
 - Turning water systems on/off and winterizing camp infrastructure

Required Skills & Qualifications:

- Ability to perform physically demanding tasks
- Strong problem-solving and mechanical skills
- Team-oriented with good communication skills

Preferred (but not required):

- Ontario Boating License (mandatory for boat operations)
- Basic knowledge of tools, equipment, and small engines
- Experience in carpentry, landscaping, or boat maintenance
- First Aid/CPR certification

Compensation & Benefits

Wages

- Competitive hourly pay
- Additional honorariums for specialized roles (e.g., lifeguard certification)
- Opportunities for performance-based bonuses

Room & Board:

- **Private accommodations** with Wi-Fi, TV, full kitchen, and private bathroom
- 3 meals per day provided when the Dining Hall is open (June August)
- Free laundry facilities
