What can I expect on a typical day?

While every day is different on the bay, work tends to vary by whether Camp is in Season (June – August) or out-of-Season (April - June & September – October)

In Season: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are served in the dining hall for staff and campers. Workdays could consist of deploying boats, collecting garbage, repairing docks and groundskeeping. Housekeeping team could turnover cottages and clean camp facilities.

Out-of-Season: Days consist of opening and cleaning cottages & camp buildings for Housekeeping and cleaning grounds, repairing winter wear & tear, turning on/off camp water system for Maintenance team.
